Instructions: Listen to the Shabbat audio reading together as a small group. Have your bibles with you and read along. After listening, go through the discussion questions below.

Date: July 15, 2023

Scripture Reading: Daniel 7: 17-27, Num 36:1-13, 1 Chron 19:1-21:30, Romans 2:25-3:8, Psalm 11:1-7, Prov 19:10-11

1. What are some of the things going on in our world that have you most concerned? What angers you and vexes your spirit?

2. Read Daniel 7: 17-21. What are the characteristics of this fourth and final end of days beast system?

3.Read Daniel 7:21-25. What else do you glean and learn about this fourth final beast system? How long does this beast system last?

4.Do you see any similarity to this forth beast system (described in Daniel 7) what we see going on in the world today?

5. What are some of the effects that this fourth beast system have upon the Saints of God?

6.What are some things we can do to guard and protect ourselves from the tactics of this Dreadful and Terrifying Beast system?

7. Read Daniel 7:26-28. What encourages you from these scriptures?

8.Read Psalm 11:1-4. The Psalmist asks "**If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?**" We are seeing the foundations of the United States of America being utterly destroyed. The Courts have been weaponized with ultra-liberal judges. We have a two tiered justice system, one for Antifa, BLM, and Hunter Biden (slap on the wrist, or catch and release) and another tier for conservative patriots (the J6 prisoners, and Donald Trump).
